Ron Dunn/Jim Bailey

Follow through on delivering recommendations to the State Office of Education, in consultation with Larry Newton, for plan review of new school construction.

Other Standing Committee chairpersons

Continue refining key strategies (i.e., specific "action plans") for proposed adoption and advocacy by the Commission during the coming year. Consider the rapid growth and development curve on the Wasatch Front--how do we intervene to make a real difference?

Create a task force for I-15 Strong-Motion Instrumentation, as directed by a motion approved at the July 17 Commission meeting.

Staff

Facilitate statewide presentations by Carl Carpenter on the earthquake vulnerability of water and wastewater systems (provide Mr. Carpenter with state guidelines on travel expenses, per diem, and reimbursement; circulate his current overheads to appropriate commissioners for possible update; provide him with copying services to reproduce his presentation packets).

Correct p. 3 of the minutes of the April 8, 1998 USSC meeting; in paragraph 1, change "...on the Brigham City segment..." to "...in the Brigham City region..."
