SUBJECT: Task assignments from the January 14, 2000 meeting

At the January 14, 2000 meeting of the USSC, the following task assignments were made:

#### Representative Bush, Senator Knudson

Sponsor legislation to amend the Utah Seismic Safety Commission Act, revising Commission membership; enabling the acceptance of contributions, grants, or other funding; and designating unspent funds up to \$10,000 as nonlapsing.

#### Gary Christenson, Geoscience Standing Committee

Facilitate the implementation of recommendations in the final report on Local Government Needs for Geoscience Information by the joint USSC and UGS Guidelines Advisory Committee.

#### Engineering & Architecture and Lifelines & Infrastructure Standing Committees

Revisit the Strategic Plan objectives, proposing revisions to reflect progress in implementation of strategies and current needs.
