Welcome and Introduction of Members and Visitors/Approval of Minutes

Keith Koper asked for introductions and invited attendees to introduce themselves. He asked for a review of the minutes.

Update from the USSC Subcommittee for Earthquake Scenario Development Divya Chandrasekhar discussed the need to update the Earthquake Scenario for more frequent disasters in Utah. She discussed new science, new leverage, high-probability scenarios, growing interest, and new assessment methods. She discussed multiple opportunities and

Discussion on USSC Recommendations to the Utah Legislature

Jessica Chappell, provided an update on the USSC Subcommittee for the Earthquake Scenario development and discussed the Utah K-12 Public Schools Unreinforced Masonry Inventory. Jessica further discussed the commission's recommendations from last year keeping four out of five recommendations, with improving further outreach efforts. The Commission discussed interest groups and public outreach to these special interest groups.

- 1. Aqueducts projects—updates in funding requests
- 2. URM Schools—make appropriations request more helpful to Local Education Agencies (LEAs)
- 3. Public Information—tailor the request to improve the chances of adoption
- 4. Code Enforcement—building partnerships
- 5. Additional Endorsements—working with UTA, PTA, APA, Utah State Superintendents Association, and AIA of Utah.

Jessica Chappell made a motion that the Commission endorses the updates to recommendations, adding coordination with additional endorsements.

Leon Berrett seconded the motion.

The vote was unanimous.

Discussion on Recent Water Aqueduct Tours to Members of the Utah Legislature and Other Public Officials

Ari Bruening provided a presentation regarding recent Water Aqueduct Tours that were provided to elected officials. He demonstrated the numbers the water districts are requesting including the \$175 million spread across four years. Ari referenced key Legislative leaders who were in attendance.

Update on the Recent Utah Geological Survey West Valley Fault Zone Paleoseismic Investigation and a Summary of the Basin and Range Earthquake Summit

Adam Hiscock provided an update on recent Utah Geological Survey work along the West Valley Fault Zone Paleoseismic Investigation and a summary of the 2022 Basin and Range Earthquake Summit (BRES). He referenced the studies and publications that are available for

review. Adam gave special recognition and thanks to the Commission and staff who supported and worked to make BRES successful.

Update on Utah Building Codes and from the USSC ATC-20 SAP Committee
Jim McClintock provided an in-depth update on the Utah Building Codes and the ATC-20
SAP program. He discussed the history of building codes, funding, and the overall development process. He discussed the involvement of building officials and discussed their involvement in FEMA, funding, and code adoption processes.
