 - i. USSC should be a catalyst to give its support and endorsement to other agencies, groups and organizations. Also should seek support and endorsement from same.
 - ii. USSC should be a mouthpiece to enhance the level of information to the public and its awareness of earthquake safety.
 - iii. USSC should give awards and recognition to other agencies, groups and organizations for their level of involvement within the earthquake awareness community.
 - iv. USSC should help fund programs that are currently working on earthquake preparedness.
 - v. Commissioners need to be more involved in Commission activities.
 - vi. USSC needs to enhance the level of information given to the public. An information packet should be available for those in need.
 - vii. Enlarge the involvement from the communities. USSC should think about an annual conference for other agencies, groups, organizations and the public on earthquake awareness. (04/11/03)
